BARA Award:

The Best All Round Archer award will be awarded to the archer who achieves the highest accumulative score for the National Field, Indoor and Target (1440 and 900) Championships. To be eligible for this award archers MUST have shot the Open distances for each of the above tournaments.

There will be a Bara Award for the following categories:
Recurve Men, Recurve Women, Compound Men, Compound Women, Barebow Men and Barebow Women.

SPECTATORS:

Entry to spectators will be free.
Tiered seating will be provided for spectators to provide an improved view of the field of play to that which was available at the 2024 NTC.
We are expecting local schools to be in attendance throughout the week.

MEMBERSHIP:

All competitors **MUST** be a financial member of Archery Australia through Assemble Sports or a financial member of a World Archery affiliated Member Association.

ACCOMMODATION & TRAVEL

Competitors are responsible for making their own accommodation and travel arrangements.
The OC are currently working on sponsorship arrangements through local hotels.

CATERING:

Lunch will be available for ordering at the time of your registration this will be \$20 per order per day and will include:

- Wrap or Sandwich (dietary options available)
- Your choice of juice or water
- Your choice of seasonal fruit (3 options each day)
- Your choice of cake, slice, or muffin (5 options each day)

The OC have sourced a different supplier those used last year

WATER:

Water will be available via water dispensers near the waiting line. Archers to provide their own containers.

PARKING:

Parking is available in the parking area adjacent to fields 3 & 4 with access via Masterman St. grounds.

MERCHANDISE:

APPEALS:

A \$150.00 (Australian currency) fee for disputes, protests or appeals shall apply and is refundable if the appeal is successful. The fee for an unsuccessful appeal will be paid to Archery Australia.

WITHDRAWAL/REFUNDS:

A full refund, less a 10% administration fee, will be made if the Organising Committee is advised of the withdrawal before the closing date for entries, i.e., 10.00pm 19th September 2025

If this advice of withdrawal is received after the closing date, refunds will be as follows
Before 10pm 1st November a 50% refund will be provided
After 1st November no refund will be available.

COACHES:

There will be no coaches accredited for the National Championship. However, if you are successful in making it to the medal matches on Saturday you will be able to have a coach on the finals field. There is to be no coaching by anyone on the tournament field during the event.

Only archers (whilst competing), officials and accredited agents will be allowed on the competition field during the event.

RGB coaches and managers can be on the field of play but only to look after the well being of their team members, they must be accredited, be seated whilst shooting is taking place and must not proceed past the waiting line. This group cannot coach whilst on the field of play.

ARCHER AGENTS:

Any agents who are accompanying archers onto the tournament field will need to be accredited to gain access. This would be for those Para archers who are competing. If you require an agent to score for you and/or assistant, you will need to inform the OC so that accreditation can be arranged. An agent cannot coach an archer.

Para Archers MUST arrange their own agents.

The venue will be open for official practice on Monday 17th November from 9.00am and will be closed for the opening ceremony and photos.

1440 ROUND / 6 ARROW ENDS:

All archers will shoot 6 arrow ends for all distances of the 1440 round.

Target Faces

All male & female Open recurve archers will shoot on the 80cm 10-5 scoring zone target faces for their two shortest distances.

All compound archers will shoot on the 80cm 10-5 scoring zone target faces for their two shortest distances.

DRESS REGULATIONS:

To present the best possible image for our sport, to our sponsors and to the general public, Archery Australia Rule 7.11, Dress Regulations, will be enforced.

No boardshorts.

Athletes shall be neatly and cleanly dressed. Such attire may be White, Club, RGB or sponsor related merchandise.

NO Archery Australia, Olympic or Paralympics uniforms can be worn. Archers will not be allowed to shoot if any of the above is worn (this includes shorts and track pants).

During inclement weather conditions athletes may wear suitable protective clothing at their discretion. Shoes or boots shall be always worn by athletes and agents, and these shall cover the entire foot; sandals or thongs are not permitted.

The following items of clothing are not permitted:

- Clothing with inappropriate or offensive images, slogans or advertising
- Untidy, unclean, damaged or torn clothing
- Clothing with "camouflage colours", which may be trademarked or other digital designs, whether random or not and regardless of colours used, consist of natural material camouflage patterns such as bark, twigs, or leaves that are used for the purpose of blending

in with natural environments thereby providing less visibility. (Clothing with non-traditional colours such as pinks, blues, bright yellow, etc. in camouflage patterns that are used in designs for the purpose of blending in with natural environments providing less visibility are also considered camouflage)

NOTES:

As electronic scoring via Archers Diary for the 1440 and 900 rounds will be used for this event, with the WA720 ranking round and ALL Matchplay scored via IANSEIO, all archers are responsible for ensuring your scores are entered into Archers Diary or IANSEIO at the completion of each round. Please ensure your scoring device is fully charged before arriving at the range.
